THE SPEECH

China's development – next steps and new opportunities

China's National People's Congress recently endorsed the outline of China's 12th Five-Year Plan for economic and social development, setting out major policies and objectives for the next five years. What is at the core is speeding up the transformation of economic development pattern. It places greater emphasis on sustainable development, taking a more holistic approach and giving more prominence to improving people's livelihood. This will unleash great potential in China's domestic demand and provide international including Swiss companies new opportunities in doing businesses with China.

Ambassador HE Yafei has devoted his entire career to diplomacy, holding various positions at the Chinese Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Chinese missions in Zimbabwe, the United States and to the United Nations. He was China's Vice Foreign Minister and a key member of President Hu Jintao's delegation at G20 Summits and Premier Wen Jiabao's delegation at the Copenhagen Climate Change Conference. Since 2010, he has held the position of Chinese ambassador and Permanent Representative to the United Nations in Geneva.
