CAS Asian Business Law*

In the autumn semester 2019, the University of Zurich is offering a new CAS in Asian Business Law. The course is taking place in the framework of the LL.M. program International Business Law.

The Program	Asian trading partners have become more and more important in the globalized economy. However, many western companies are still unfamiliar with the specificities of the Asian and especially Chinese markets. The newly offered specialization course, which will be taught in English, is designed to give participants the understanding of the regulatory and legal characteristics of Asia's key markets and thus better assess opportunities and risks.
	Module 1: Institutional & Structural Framework Module 2: Country Specific Legal Aspects of Trade and Investment
	The first module deals with basic questions of cross-border issues when dealing with Asia. Beside economic and legal challenges, issues relating to the protection of investments and cross-border finance as well as the importance of free trade agreements are discussed. Furthermore, the «One Belt One Road initiative» and possible investment and trading structures will be examined.
	The second module deals with country-specific legal aspects of trade and investment. The focus will be on the following countries: China, Hong Kong, India, Indonesia, Japan, Kazakhstan, South Korea, Malaysia and Vietnam.
	Students who wish to achieve an LL.M. title can extend their studies and do an LL.M. in International Business Law (70 ECTS).
Target Audience	The CAS Asian Business Law (19 ECTS) is intended for professionals who wish to gain an in-depth knowledge of legal and business aspects of Asian Business Law.
Teaching Language	The entire course is conducted in English.
Application Deadline	30 April 2019
Course Duration	6 September 2019 until 8 February 2020, classes are held Friday in the afternoons and Saturday in the mornings.
Costs	CHF 9,500, included in the tuition costs are the costs for course materials, examination fees as well as one block seminar (2 days).
